Sponsor Information

The role of a sponsor in the Sacrament of Confirmation is very important. While being a sponsor is an honor, it is important to choose a sponsor who is active in our Catholic faith, will be connected to you during the course of your life and will take the role seriously.

The Code of Canon Law of the Catholic Church notes the following requirements (Can. 874 §1.2°-1.4°, 892-893):

874 – §1. To be admitted to the role of sponsor, a person must:

2° have completed the sixteenth year, unless a different age has been established by the diocesan bishop or it seems to the pastor or minister that an exception is to be made for a just cause;

3° be a Catholic who has been confirmed and has already received the sacrament of the Most Holy Eucharist and leads a life in harmony with the faith and the role to be undertaken;

4° not be bound by any canonical penalty legitimately imposed or declared;

892 – As far as possible a sponsor for the one to be confirmed should be present; it is for the sponsor to see that the confirmed person acts as a true witness to Christ and faithfully fulfills the obligations connected with this sacrament.

893 – §1. To perform the role of sponsor, it is necessary that a person fulfill the conditions mentioned in can. 874.

§2. It is desirable that the one who undertook the role of sponsor at baptism be sponsor for confirmation.

- 1) Candidates may have only ONE sponsor unless both are the candidate's baptismal sponsors (godparents) and they continue to meet the requirements of the Church.
- 2) If married sponsors must be married in the Catholic Church. If unmarried, sponsors must be living a chaste life (unmarried persons living with someone of the opposite sex are not permitted to be sponsors).
- 3) The father or mother of the person to be confirmed may not be the sponsor.

A request must be made to the parish office where the potential sponsor is a registered parishioner. Your sponsor may contact their parish office to have the form signed.

You may not include any activities that provide you a benefit (e.g. a car wash to earn payment for a sports team).

- Help a teacher

You may not include any activities that provide you a benefit or one that you receive payment for completing.

FAMILY--5 hours required

- Any family chore or work project where you do not get paid for helping
- Organize a family night for a get-together
- Help your parents or grandparents with a project
- Make a pilgrimage to Chimayo or other places
- Babysit siblings

LETTER TO ARCHBISHOP JOHN C. WESTER

Use 12 pt. Arial or Times New Roman font, single-spaced, double space between paragraphs, 1 inch margins. Please keep your letter to one typewritten page. The team will look the letter over, make suggestions, and return it to you for corrections if necessary. It is important that all letters be turned in on time. Do not send this letter yourself. The parish will send these letters together. The Archbishop will read all letters, **so write what's in red in your own words** and follow **these instructions**. The following is the appropriate format. Do not change the spacing. The text in black should be copied. Red and Blue text must not be copied. This must be turned in no later than February 2019

Your Excellency:

In preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation, reflecting on my own life, my personal desire to be united to Christ and His Church more fully, and to be strengthened by the Gift of the Holy Spirit, I have come to a fuller understanding of myself, my relationship with God and the Communion of Saints, and my call to serve the Church and the world with the Gifts I intend to receive at Confirmation.

Knowing the importance of taking a Saint's name I have chosen... (tell what name you chose and why. Remember there is a twofold purpose in taking a new name. First, you will be taking an intercessor who will pray on your behalf, and for this reason, official patronages are important to mention. Second, it is important to take a saint as an example of how to incorporate virtues and the Gifts of the Holy Spirit into your daily life. You may wish to explain what virtues this saint possesses and how you can imitate these virtues in your own life.)

After prayerful discernment, I have chosen my sponsor. (tell the archbishop who you have chosen, what your relation to them is, and why you have chosen them. Remember, this person is meant to be as a parent to you for the rest of your life for the purpose of helping you grow into a well-formed, faithful Catholic. This person is to assist you in becoming a Saint.)

In growing in my faith, I have also grown in my appreciation for being Catholic and will use my time and talent to serve the Church. (Explain how you will use your talent and time to service your parish community.)

I respectfully ask with your permission and approval that I be admitted to the Sacrament of Confirmation for the completion of the graces begun in my Baptism.

It is in appreciation that I thank you for this privilege and promise to pray for you and our Church. (Or whatever you feel is appropriate)
